

## Maths



In Maths we will be looking at:

- Place value (2 digit numbers)
- Counting forwards and backwards from any given number in 1s, 2s, 5s and 10s.
- Ordering, reading and writing numbers to 100
- Number bonds to 20 and related subtraction facts.
- Addition and addition problems
- Subtraction and subtraction problems



## English

To start the term we will be reading and writing our own traditional tales and stories. We will be focusing on 'The Enormous Turnip', 'Oliver's Vegetables', 'Super Daisy and the Peril of Planet Pea'. The children will act out parts of the story, create their own story maps and innovate the stories to write their own versions.

After making our own smoothies, children will be writing instructions on how to make a healthy food bar or smoothie.

## Topic - Fit and Healthy
