Dear Parents and Carers,

Thank you for your patience through the past few weeks of lockdown. We feel very proud of how we, as a school community (children, families and staff) have dealt with all the challenges we have had thrown at us.

We are delighted to report that school will reopen to all pupils on Monday 8th March 2021. Doors will open at 8.40am and any children arriving after 9am will be marked as late. Parents / carers will be able to collect their children at 3pm Monday to Thursday.

Initially there will be no breakfast club and school will continue to finish at 12.45pm on a Friday. We will review both the opening of breakfast club and school closing early on a Friday before the Easter break, and update you.

Please remember to only send your children to school if they and members of their household are totally free of any Covid-19 symptoms. Children will continue to remain within their classroom bubbles and will mix with their key stage hubs only when outside.

In school we will continue with all the additional cleaning and hygiene to ensure that we keep everyone safe. To reduce the number of people on the school site we ask that only one parent / carer drops-off and collects their child.

Children will enter and exit through the same doors they did before Christmas.

We do hope that your children are looking forward to returning to school and we will do all we can to help them settle back and catch up with any missed learning. We can't wait to have a school full of children again!
