

Covid Update 09.07.21

Dear Parents / Carers,

We just wanted to update you on the situation around Covid 19 in school. We have now had three confirmed positive cases this week and some children with symptoms.

The cases have been in Nursery, Year 1 and Year 5. These bubbles have therefore been closed for the 10-day isolation period. Families of children in these year groups have received the appropriate information. We are also awaiting PCR results after positive LFT tests in Year 3 and Year 4.

We have also needed to close some classrooms due to a shortage of staffing. This is to ensure we can run school safely. Staff shortage is occurring because when the families of our staff members have to isolate, they do too.


